



Code of Conduct for Teaching Staff

- Demonstrating professional competence to teach and learn, being honest and encouraging honesty in all academic and other human activities.
- Honestly projecting the work by not indulging in copyright/IPR violation
- Making the services available at all times for the development of students, the institution and the Society.
- Providing honest and objective feedback that will help students to assess their learning and progress towards their goals
- Demonstrating the courage to speak the truth and do the right thing.
- Treating students, colleagues and management with respect, using respectful language within and outside the portals of the institution
- Disclosing upfront, rules and policies followed with respect to confidentiality of student records.
- Student records and private communications to be treated as confidential materials and released only with consent of student or as per disclosed policy where there is reasonable ground for disclosure and such disclosure is in the interest of the student or to prevent harm to others.
- Developing reciprocity and cooperation among students and working in harmony with management and colleagues to make one's institution and community a better place for work.
- Getting involved in community development by applying one's knowledge through carefully and systematically planned activities.
