IQAC Annual Report 2020-2021

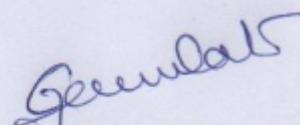
The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) aspires to achieve excellence. Regular meetings with the staff, a student orientation programme, and student-teacher interaction being performed by the IQAC of Vikas Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences (VIPS) as a measure. IQAC conducts staff evaluations and student feedback questionnaires with the intention of offering essential input and ideas for quality maintenance and improvement in teaching, learning, and research at the institution. It records and reports on the college's numerous operations in order to meet higher education criteria. Follow-ups on the college's infrastructure resources are done on a regular basis to ensure enough, suitable, and improved facilities to ensure a positive learning, teaching, and research environment IQAC serves as a vital component of the college, assuring quality and continual development in most of the college's units and aspects, through all of these measurements and activities. IQAC expresses its thanks to VIPS management, staff, students, funding agencies, and parents for their contributions to the institute's excellent sustenance and preservation.

On 15th Jun 2020, IQAC meeting was held and the meeting proceedings resolved that the student internal assessments in the sessional examinations through the results and to find the lacunae. The proceedings further extended to motivate the students to take their competitive examination such as PGCET/GPAT and other examinations if any. Students were encouraged to take the examinations to pursue higher education in abroad like GRE, TOFEL, IELTS and other if any. It also discussed with the staff to motivate the students to give seminars on regular basis to assess their leadership qualities and also the grip on the subject. If any lacunae are found teachers are instructed to counsel them, resolve the student's backlogs.

On 23rd Oct 2020, meeting with IQAC was proceeded to discuss the key information as well to strengthen the cooperation in National events, seminars, conferences and also other event participations. It has suggested expanding the wings in the recurrence of Industrial visits, Expert talks, Industrial openness preparing from Industry people, Membership and MoU's to investigate the different functional parts of modern improvement to the understudies. The different parts of fortifying of student associations and exercising to advance their interests in specialized occasions like encouraging for poster/oral/research works in the Nation/International events/seminars/conferences. The meeting called by the members to plan more activities in National Social Scheme Special Camp such as Awareness about Digitization, Swatch Bharat Abhiyan, and Health awareness.

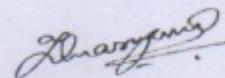
On 8th Jan 2021, IQAC meeting proceedings resolved that the academic audit has to be undertaken by each department in the presence of Vice principal, HOD and a faculty member. An online feedback form by the students has to fill after completion of the course and the lacunae has to be identified to rectify the backlogs of the staff. IQAC motivated staff and students to enroll for the value added courses or any certificate courses which improves their contribution to the academics as well as the career growth. As we are using Vmedulife platform since 2018 and this system has to upgrade to the current syllabi.

On 11th March 2021, IQAC held a meeting with all the staff members and the meeting proceedings were resolved to have coordinators for individual criteria's for NAAC SSR preparation. IQAC has instructed all the coordinators to update the documents of five years in the prescribed format. The placement in-charge is instructed to develop association with the companies that conducts on-campus or off-campus recruitment. CBCS was developed and PCI inculcated the same with syllabi. It was instructed to follow the same as part of the curriculum.

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The IQAC report for the Academic year 2020-2021 briefs the various initiatives, activities, events, MoU's, examination cell, syllabi etc., the resolutions made out of which VIPS succeeded in few criterions.

IQAC held a meeting on 22nd April 2021, with proceedings of inculcating student internal assessments for the mentorship, by which mentor can guide their respective mentee in forthcoming examinations as well other examinations. It was also discussed with NAAC coordinator for further updates on the criterion works as per NAAC, the in-charges are instructed to give a demo on the information gathered.

On 10th May 2021, IQAC proceedings resolved that pattern for criteria was briefly described by the Vice principal and decided to circulate among the coordinators and faculty. Committee has to involve in improving quality parameters. The department wise assessment of quality has to be done by the respective heads. IQAC suggested few quality parameters for the moderate working departments.

IQAC proceedings were held in the month of July 22nd 2021, the meeting resolved in having a change in the IQAC committee on the basis of recent changes. It was reported that IIQA was submitted to the NAAC by the HEI. It was also suggested to update all the profiles of the faculty in the earlier submitted format. The reports of the criterions need to be submitted to the coordinator for review in a week twice. Any other relevant changes are noted need to be updated with the given time bound.

On 16th Aug 2021, the IQAC meeting discussed on the acceptance of IIQA, all documents should be attested by the head of the institution and all the relevant data has to be filed. The time timelines to submit Self Study Report (SSR) has been discussed and the work allotted to the faculty members will be discussed by the respective heads. IQAC had a word with all the teaching and non-teaching staff regarding the balance of the curriculum as well as SSR submission as prescribed by the NAAC formats.

In September 2021, IQAC had discussions with all the faculty members in presence of the chairperson regarding technical support, issues in categorizing the data etc. the criteria coordinators has updated the work done by each and the lacunae found were rectified by the NAAC coordinator as well the IQAC chairperson.

IQAC held meeting on 18th Feb 2022, for further proceedings the NAAC coordinator along with the chairperson resolved that staff will be assigned with respective works and the report has to be submitted to the coordinator or respective department heads on an alternate day basis. The work progress from each faculty members as well as non-teaching staff members need to be reported to the head of the institution by the IQAC coordinator. Apart from the NAAC works, this meeting discussed regarding PG projects guide allotment which was given to the head of the departments for further decision. It is resolved that all the class in-charges of B.Pharm, M.Pharm and Pharm D are instructed to collect the feedback for the previous semester as well as from fresher's for further implementations or rectifications.
